Dress Code

The intention of the dress code is to ensure that clothes are clean, correctly sized, and school appropriate. In any situation where attire is debatable, the final determination of whether it is allowable rests with the division director. Dress codes for field trips may vary according to the nature of the field trip. If you are ever unsure if an item is dress-code appropriate, please contact the division director to discuss.

Tops: CBA Spirit Wear, Polo shirts (long or short sleeve), Button-down Oxford shirts (long or short sleeve), Blouses (collared or collarless), T-shirts that contain no inappropriate words or images, Sweaters, turtlenecks, or fleeces, Sweatshirts and hooded sweatshirts.

No sleeveless shirts, tank tops, or bare midriffs. Shirts must cover mid-section when arms are raised.

Bottoms: Dress pants, or appropriate fitting, non-tattered, denim jeans and sweatpants (pants must be worn at or above the hips and must fit properly), Dresses, shorts, skirts, and skorts - must be long enough to provide coverage during active learning and play; therefore, they should be knee length or longer, Leggings may be worn under dresses, skirts, shorts or long shirts/sweaters

No pajama pants, bike shorts, miniskirts, saggy pants, tight/clingy pants, or pants that are split, frayed, or torn.

Shoes: Neat and clean dress shoes, sneakers, or sandals with backs

No slip-ons, flip-flops, Crocs, slides, beach or shower sandals
